

DIPLOMA IN HAIRCUTTING

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course lays the Classic Foundation for all Haircutting. The angling and cutting techniques used in these Classic cuts will help you create advanced haircuts. On the 5 Classic Techniques are performed the many variations to provide different looks. This course inculcates the much needed discipline that enables students to become hairdressers with a keen sense & understanding of Hair - Form, Shape and Look.

ELIGIBILITY: Ladies & Gents in age group 15-40 preferably.

OBJECTIVE

At the end of this course, Students will have a strong foundation in Classic Hair Cutting. They also have a clear understanding of the Physiological structure of Hair and handling different hair types. They will be able to consult clients and make independent decisions on style and services to be performed

DURATION: 6 weeks, 5 days a week, 4 hours a day

Hair Fundamentals

Shampoo & Conditioning, Basic Trichology, Hair Design, Cutting tools, Choosing the Hair cut, Sectioning Techniques Blow Drying, Cutting Basics, Accuracy & Checking, Finishing Principles of a Haircut

- Flat Across – 0 degree vertical section, a-line section, orange section
- Zero degree convex v section, convex tapered angle
- Forward Graduation
- Natural inversion
- Square Layers
- Border 45 degree paneling
- Extended graduation
- 90 degree over head projection round layer
- Classic 45 degree paneling
- Classic Bob

DIPLOMA IN ADVANCE HAIRCUTTING

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course builds on the Classic Foundation of Haircutting. This course introduces variations in Angling, Cutting, and Shaping & Texturising techniques. Advanced techniques help hairdressers to mould and shape hair into numerous styles and shapes thereby creating versatility and enhanced sense & understanding of Hair - Form, Shape and Look.

ELIGIBILITY: Ladies & Gents in age group 15-40 preferably.

PRE REQUISITES: Should have sound knowledge and strong foundation in basic Haircuts, Angling and Cutting techniques.

OBJECTIVE

1. Students will be proficient in the various advanced techniques in Hair Molding and Shaping
2. Students have a deeper understanding of the Physiological structure of Hair and a deep understanding of handling different hair types.
3. Students will be able to consult clients and make independent decisions on style and services to be performed

DURATION: 6 weeks, 5 days a week, 4 hours a day

Shape of head and face Profiles, Features of Head and face Hair quality & quantity, The perfect face

Hair Cutting Advanced

Connected & Disconnected, Overlay Border, Free Flow Connected & Disconnected, Summer Fly, Turtle Back, Increased Layering, Overlapping Layering, Barbering 90° Layering, Razor Cut, Angular Pyramid

Cutting Techniques

Notching, Deep Notching, Thinning, Slicing, Carving, Flipping, Jaggging, Point Cutting, Castle Separation

Blow-drying techniques to finish the above cuts
